Meet Chrislande

When Chrislande Jourdin's husband passed away in 2015 after a long illness, her world changed overnight.

Suddenly, she found herself alone, raising five children with no income and no clear way to provide for them. Her youngest child was just four years old. There were days when the family had no food to eat and times when even clean drinking water was beyond their reach.

In the midst of overwhelming hardship, Chrislande chose faith over despair.

She prayed that God would provide, then did everything she could with what she had. Borrowing just \$300, she began selling secondhand clothing, walking from community to community with the clothes draped over her arms. Every sale meant another meal for her children or another step toward paying their school tuition.

The journey has not been easy. Her children were sent home from school more than once because tuition could not be paid. Yet Chrislande never stopped fighting for their future. Through her perseverance and God's faithfulness, three of her children have graduated from high school, and her oldest is now attending college.

Today, Chrislande continues to work tirelessly to care for her family, trusting the Lord to meet each day's needs. This Christmas, through Project Cornelius, you can encourage a mother who has never given up and remind her that she is not carrying this burden alone.



Meet Nalson

At just three years old, Nalson Bazelais experienced unimaginable loss. After the death of his father, his mother passed away only a short time later, leaving him an orphan.

With nowhere else to go, his aunt, Marie Bazelais, welcomed him into her home and raised him as her own son. Though she and her family have very little, they have never stopped loving and caring for Nalson. Despite having no steady income, they have made countless sacrifices to keep him in school, trusting God to provide for their daily needs.

Today, Nalson is 16 years old. Because of years of hardship and interrupted schooling, he is preparing to enter the seventh grade. His family has fallen behind on tuition payments, and without help, he may not be able to continue his education this year.

Yet Nalson has not given up on his dream.

He hopes to become a doctor one day so he can care for others and give back to his community. He knows that education is the key to that future, but without the support of compassionate people, that dream may slip away.

This Christmas, through Project Cornelius, you can help give Nalson something far greater than financial assistance; you can give him hope. Your generosity can help keep him in school and remind him that he is not forgotten, but deeply loved by God and His people.
